**CLOSING DATE: 06 December 2024 at 17H00**

The Department of Sport, Arts and Culture hereby invites suitable project proposals and applications from Non-Profit Organisations/Companies (NPOs/NPCs) that are working and actively involved in the Arts, Culture and Heritage sectors. Organisations that implement Elements of a Gender Based Violence Prevention Programmes are an added advantage. Organisations should focus on mainstream and or facilitate participation and development of the following Target Groups:

1. Children
2. Persons living with Disabilities
3. Older Persons
4. Women

Registered NPOs/NPCs from all nine (9) provinces are invited to submit proposals. This Call for Proposals is for projects that will be implemented **between April 2025 and March 2026** financial year.

**Conditions for acceptance of application:**

- Detailed proposal with an itemised budget for one of the above Target Groups
- Budget should not exceed R1 000 000.00
- Valid SARS Good standing document
- Valid South African-based registered Non-Profit Organization (NPO) or Non-Profit Company (NPC) Certificate
- Letter of Authority from the organisation appointing leading member or project/liaison manager, with this letter for the project (signed by at least three or all of the Executive members).
- Certified Identification Copy of project/liaison manager
- Bank Confirmation Letter for Account
- Non-Profit Organisation (NPO) compliance letter from the National Department of Social Development.
- Applicants who were funded within the last three years will not be considered.
- Applications must be submitted on or before **06 December 17:00**.

**Please note that late applications will not be considered and there will be no exceptions. Applications should be submitted to the department through the government portal [www.eservices.gov.za](http://www.eservices.gov.za).**

### 1. Pre-Conditions of Application

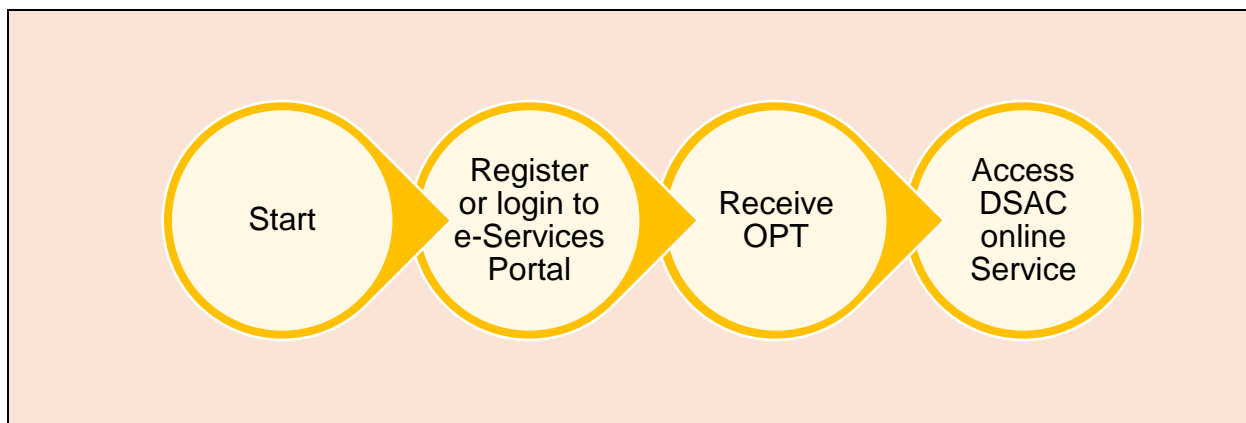
The Applicant must have;

### 2. e-SERVICES REGISTRATION AND LOGIN NARRATION

<b>Roles</b>	(a) Applicant
<b>Procedure</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. An Applicant registers on the e-services portal. Once registered the Applicant will receive a One Time Pin (OTP) to their cellphone number to verify the user.</li> <li>ii. If the Applicant has an existing profile the Applicant logs into the portal with his/her existing credentials.</li> <li>iii. Once logged in the Applicant accesses the DSAC Grant Management system which will be listed under the <b>e-services menu</b>.</li> </ol>
